Nowadays distributed energy resources (DER) can provide certain reactive power flexibility for voltage support in alternating current power systems. The change is powered by what Topol calls medicine's "Gutenberg moment." Much as the printing press took learning out of the hands of a priestly class, the mobile internet is doing the same for

Medicine has been digitized, Topol argues; now it will be democratized. Massive, open, online medicine, where diagnostics are done by Facebook-like comparisons of medical profiles, will enable real-time, real-world research on massive populations.
